- We are a theatre company in Marburg, Germany, doing all kind of performances since 1994
- We have around 100 active and passive members with all kinds of backgrounds, professional, semi-professional and amateur
- We do around 75 to 100 Shows a year
- We do plays, improvisation, children's theatre, performances, and much more



What we expect from you

- Good skills in English, speaking and hearing.
- In the long run, german is a must. We don't expect you speaking good right from the start, but understanding a conversation is vital. On arrival, you should be able to speak some german words at least!
- Being open minded and ready to try out new things.
- Being able to work on your own. Being able to make decisions and then do it with self-confidence.
- At least some experience in the arts: No professional knowledge is expected, just having done something yourself or having been part of a theatre or art project.





The Experience

You will take part in all different tasks a theatre has to offer. There are three main working fields:

- Office work: Assisting in daily routines, public relations, distributing advertisement, attending rehearsals of ongoing productions, helping out.
- Preparing shows: Be part of a production team, get an idea of all things needed to do a show properly.
- Technical issues: Get a grasp of what's necessary to run a show: Lighting, Sound, Management, Props, etc.

“How do I fit in?” – That’s up to you!

We encourage every volunteer to do his or her own project or to be part of one.

- You want to participate and assist in a big production? There’s always room for you.
- You want to do a workshop to try out new ideas with other people? We will help you getting it done.
